

# GRP Explained



**Glass Reinforced Plastic Signs (GRP)** Provides an exceptionally tough and superior sign base that cannot compare to other sign base materials i.e. wood, aluminium, acrylic or Foamex.

**Base Material** - Only Lloyd's Register approved resins & gelcoats are used, all recommended for their durability, colour stability and weather resistance.

**Strength** - Unlike some materials, e.g. acrylics & foamex, GRP will not shatter under impact. It stands up very well to all attempted vandalism.

**Cleaning** - All dirt, including graffiti, can be removed from the sign face of GRP with no deterioration to the surface. Recommended cleaning solvents are available.

**Colour Fastness** - It is very unlikely that any other material can match the potential life expectancy of GRP signs. Minimum life expectancy is 10 years.

**Reusable** - Due to the ease of cleaning, vinyl text can be professionally removed and replaced without leaving any visible marks.

**Maintenance** - Only an occasional clean with water & detergent is required to keep GRP signs in their original, pristine condition.

**Fixings** - There are no face fixings to GRP signs to detract from the copy & graphics. All fixings are concealed and suitable for wall or post mounting.
